# Print Making Workshop

Saturday, January 19, 2019 10 am to 3 pm

Instructor: Pat Morrison

Mt. Hope Community Center, 104 Pushaw Station Rd  
Sunderland, MD,

In this workshop, students will learn how to create a linoleum block printing plate and print it to make multiple note cards. Linoleum block printing is similar to wood block printing. The block is carved in a way that removes the areas that the artist does not want to print. The finished, carved block is then rolled with ink; the ink adheres only to the raised surfaces. Paper is placed onto the inked surface, rubbed, and then separated from the block to reveal the finished print.

Students will learn how to get different effects by inking the plate with multiple colors and overprinting the plate a second time. All supplies will be provided, but students should bring ideas and images to work from. The cards will measure 5 1/2" X 8 1/2", so any sketches or images should be sized to fit within these dimensions.



## Pat Morrison

Pat Morrison was born in Washington DC and currently lives in Chesapeake Beach, Maryland. She received her BFA in Communication Arts and Design from Virginia Commonwealth University, and has also studied at the Corcoran College of Art and Design and Montgomery College of Maryland.

For 20 years, Morrison worked as a freelance editorial illustrator for a variety of magazines, newspapers and associations. Later she taught art for District of Columbia Public Schools at the Fillmore Arts Center, and recently retired from teaching art for Charles County Public Schools.

Morrison's work is highly influenced by nature. Her recent work focuses on linocuts combined with underpaintings. She is a member of CalvART Gallery in Prince Frederick, Md. Past shows include the Waldorf West Library Gallery, Twin Beaches Library, North End Gallery Invitational, and Calvert Nature Society Nature's ARTcade Exhibit. Her work is also found at Dockside Restaurant in Deale, Md. She teaches printmaking workshops at various locations in Calvert County.

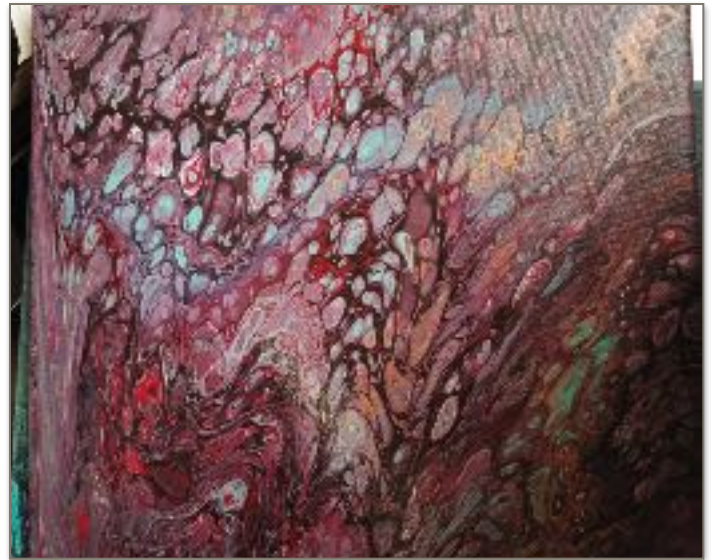

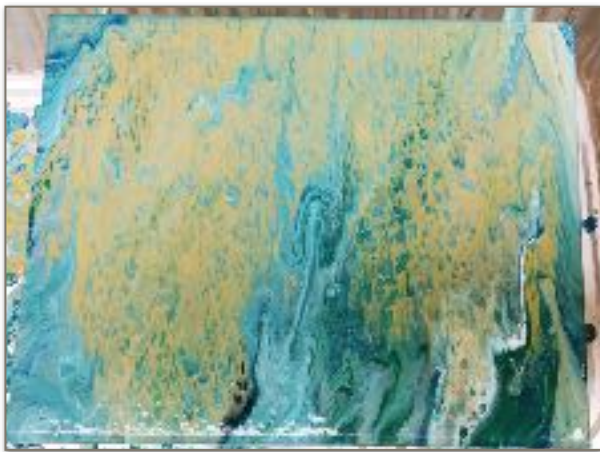
