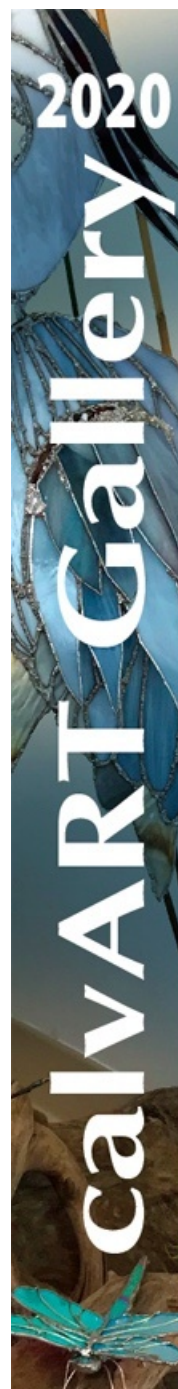
My thanks to all CAG members! It always impresses me to see how fast we can put our shows up, and take them down – all because of great teamwork!

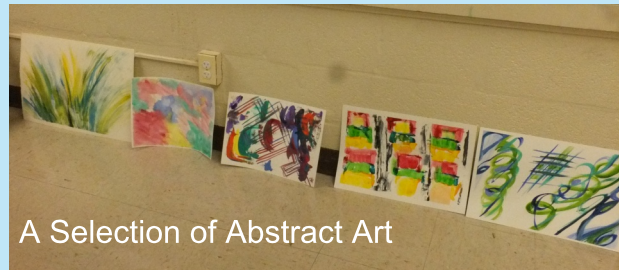
“Discover Your Abstract Self” CAG Workshop in January 2020

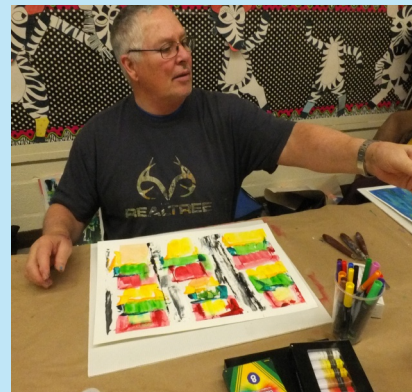
