#### ADDITIONAL NOTES ON MATTAWOMAN CREEK ART CENTER SHOW

Work will be accepted at Mattawoman Creek Art Center the 6th and 7th of August. The show will take place Friday-Sunday, August 11, 12, 13 (reception on the 13th), August 18, 19, 20, 25, 26, 27; in September it will be September 1, 2, 3, 8, 9, 10, with a plein air event on the 10th. Work may be removed after 4 pm on the 10th, or the following day, late morning-early afternoon. I will appreciate those who wish to help greet guests at the gallery any of those days. Jewelers should coordinate to make sure tables are monitored in the gallery. I will also be happy to help with that. More details will be provided as we get closer.

#### **UPCOMING WORKSHOP**

Our next workshop will be Sunday July 9<sup>th</sup>. Ray Bogle will show folks how to Raku fire and Pit Fire pottery at his studio in Prince Frederick. Ray will provide bisque ceramics to glaze and fire during the workshop. Ray has offered the Guild a special fee so this workshop is for members only and has limited spaces. Please note that the workshop fee is \$60 for this amazing opportunity.

Ray Bogle has been working with clay for over 30 years and exploring Alternative Firing techniques including Raku, Saggar, and Pit Firing. Through patient experimentation and perseverance, he has learned to keep things simple and trust the firing to allow the pots to "decorate themselves" and produce subtle organic patterns on each piece. Ray continues to explore different ways of varying aspects of the firings to produce increased pattern and color depth sometimes resulting from multiple firings from different techniques. He enjoys teaching pottery for beginning or more advanced potters and regularly conducts Alternative Firing Workshops in the Mid-Atlantic area.

#### The following criteria will be used to facilitate judging:

- 1. Elements of design: Use of line, form, space (positive and negative) color, texture (visual and tactile)
- 2. Principles of design: Use of balance (symmetrical or asymmetrical), emphasis (point of interest), and continuity (how well through use of the elements the viewer's eye continues through the work of art towards the point of interest)
- 3. Mastery of materials and techniques
- 4. Use of imagination, inventiveness, individuality and aesthetic consistency

#### The following rules apply to this show:

- 1. There are ten categories for judging. You may enter multiple categories but no piece may be entered in more than one category.
- 2. Artwork must be original and have been completed within last two years.
- 3. Artwork must <u>not</u> have won an award in a previous CAG Show.
