Each exhibitor (or their representative) must be present for the entire show to monitor their artworks and sales. This is an outdoor show and security will be problematic. Each participant will furnish their own screens and hang his/her artworks and maintain his/her sales. (If you do not own screens, contact Gerry Wood regarding screen loans). Space allocations are based on each artist using 2 screens (both sides). The Calvert Artists' Guild will not be responsible for sales or receipts. It is suggested that in the event of inclement weather, participants bring waterproof coverings for their artwork as well as an umbrella or other personal rain protection. Exhibitors should be cognizant of wind effects on their display. The

2-dimensional works will be on screens and 3-dimensional works will be on tables on the sidewalk area.

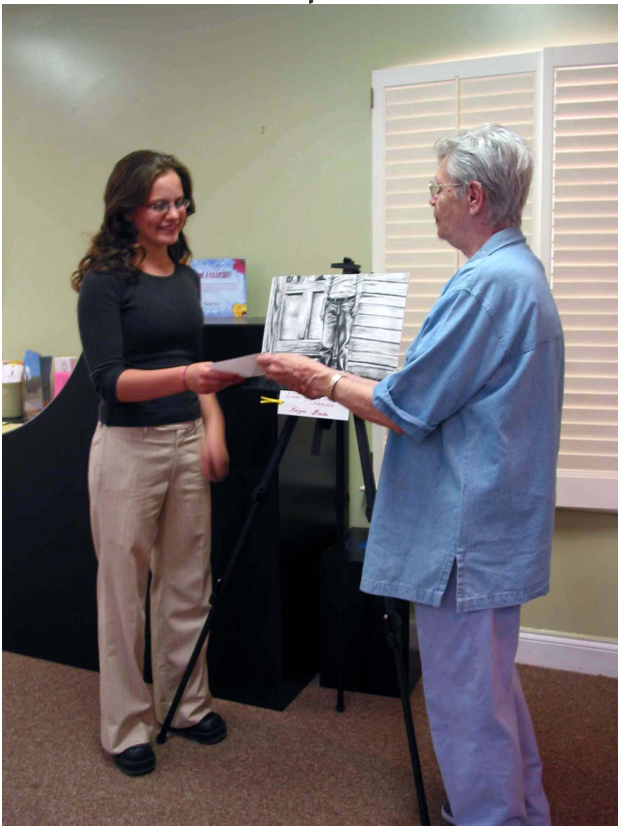
