If you are interested in the items with asterisks please call. I purchased the Guerilla Box items for plein air painting. If you enjoy painting outdoors I have everything you need right here to paint "en plein aire." I have many of the accessories for the guerilla box, see list below:

- *1. 9x12 "Guerilla Box" tripod and accessories. This is the most popular pochade box ever made (reference JudsonsArt.com). It offers efficient storage for all your supplies: leather handles, 3 storage compartments, brush tray, palette extension kit, universal tripod mount, adapter panels for smaller canvases. Holds 4 wet panels. Strong wood and well crafted with stainless steel screws. Silver deluxe soft clamp umbrella. Strong no. 17 Flex Tripod. Used gently a couple of times. \$200 for box, tripod and all accessories. (cost \$450).
- *2. Jack Richeson Deluxe LOBO Easel. Solid oak, new, never used. Adjustable for standing or sitting to paint. Top and bottom painting trays, hand rubbed oak finish, has settings for standing, sitting, forward tilt as well as horizontal, will accommodate a canvas up to 66 in. tall or flat work such as watercolor when horizontal. List price \$470 plus \$145 shipping, never used --\$200.00.
- 3. Oil paint (Soho brand, a value paint) 6 oz. tubes unopened. Crimson, Cad Yellow, Purple, Cobalt, Zinc White, Burnt Sienna -- \$5.00 each.
- 4. Paper -- Watercolor and Yupo paper, full size sheets.
- 5. Frames -- variety
- 6. Canvas -- stretched and boards
- *Wood frame futon with tan corduroy cover (includes linens) -- \$100.00 (never slept on)

*Proform Elliptical/Recumbent Hybrid Trainer. Like new -- \$150.00.

CRITERIA FOR THE AWARDS SHOW

IMPORTANT: We ask that no one hang their art until permission is given by the Show Manager.

The following criteria will be used to facilitate judging:

- 1. Elements of design: Use of line, form, space (positive and negative), color, texture (visual and tactile)
- 2. Principles of design: Use of balance (symmetrical or asymmetrical), emphasis (point of interest), and continuity (how well through use of the elements the viewer's eye continues through the work of art towards the point of interest)
- 3. Mastery of materials and techniques
- 4. Use of imagination, inventiveness, individuality and aesthetic consistency

The following rules apply to this show:

- 1. There are 13 categories & Best In Show for judging. You may enter multiple categories.
- 2. Artwork must be original and have been completed within the last two years.
- 3. Artwork must NOT have won an award in a previous CAG Show.
- 4. Paintings must be framed with a wire to hang them on a screen. If the canvas is 2 or 3 inches thick, it does not have to be framed, but must be painted.

AWARD WINNER CATEGORIES:

- BEST IN SHOW (Not to have won an award in the same CATEGORY)
- 1. DRAWING i.e. pencil, graphite, colored pencil, cray-pas, pen and ink, scratchboard, pastel, charcoal
 - 2 PAINTING 1- i.e. acrylic, acrylic flows *
 - 3. PAINTING 2 i.e. water media (watercolor, gouache)
 - 4 PAINTING 3 oil paintings
 - 5. MIXED MEDIA collage, papers, fibers, paint, other.
 - 6. JEWELRY i.e. metal, beading, clay, ceramic, glass, fiber, silver/gold
 - 7. PRINTMAKING i.e., wood, metal, silkscreen, linoleum, monotypes, stone,
 - 8. PHOTOGRAPHY regular, digital, digital enhanced, hand colored, silver point, gelatin, sepia, other
 - 9. SCULPTURE i.e., stone, glass, ceramic, wood, metal, bronze
 - 10. GLASS stained, fused, blown, lamp worked, etching, other
 - 11. CERAMICS/CLAY functional, non-functional, pit fire, raku, mosaic, other
 - 12.. FIBER, TEXTILES i.e., fabrics woven, pieced, knit, weaving, basketry, quilting, other
