## ARTISTS IN WONDERLAND May 6 – 8, 2022

Calvert Artists' Guild and the Color and Light Society are joining together to do an art show in Leonardtown the first weekend of May. The town of Leonardtown is extending their First Friday through the whole weekend with the theme of Mad about Leonardtown inspired by Alice in Wonderland.

We will be subleasing the Bell Motor Co. showroom (across the street from Town Hall). The show will run for three days, Friday noon – 8 pm, Saturday and Sunday 11 am – 5 pm. Friday evening we will have a reception with a musician and possibly a wine-tasting by the Port of Leonardtown Winery.

We have some sponsorship support from the St. Mary's Arts Council. The remainder of the costs will be covered by the show entry fee of \$30 per artist. Interested CAG members can send their application form (page 5) and check to the Guild P.O.Box. Applications need to be postmarked by April 18th. The Color & Light Society will collect the fees from their participating members.

The Show set up will be Thursday evening from 4:00 – 7:00 pm. You'll need to bring your art then and help set up the screens just like any other show. Closing will be at 5:00 pm on Sunday, so all participants will need to come help clean up and collect their art. Because this is a three day show we need each participant to sign up for a couple of 2 hour shifts during the show. You'll need to help with sales and wrapping/bagging the art pieces for the Guild. Pam Callen will send out an email with a sign-up sheet.

We will decide on good compositions to use for our pastel paintings based on our own photo references. We will plan and, if needed, simplify or crop our compositions and think about basics like value and perspective before we begin.

Workshop participants will choose various supports for the pastels, including black sandpaper, tan sandpaper, watercolor paper and velour, sometimes with watercolor, sometimes without. We will use hard and soft pastels and, if we wish, pastel pencils.

The workshop leader will be happy to share supplies for a small fee, based on needs and preferences of each student.
